



Kookers Kare BBQ Series

The 2016 Kookers Kare BBQ Series is a BBQ competition for teams who cook in the BBQ contests that have been donated to Kookers Kare Winter FunFest. These contest organizers have donated a free entry into their particular contest which is raffled off at the Kookers Kare Winterfest. Only those donated contest entries will be used in the calculation of an overall winner and category winners. A list of qualifying contest will be available each year during Winterfest and at the Kookers Kare website.

For BBQ teams to be eligible to compete in the Kookers Kare BBQ Series, teams must pay an entry fee of \$30. The \$30 entry fee goes to Kookers Kare as a charitable donation. Every team who enters the BBQ Series will receive points. Points will be awarded on rank as per the chart below. Additionally, every BBQ Series team will be awarded bonus points based on the total number of teams at a Kookers Kare contest, divided by 4; up to a maximum of 12.5 points. While teams are rewarded for doing well in large contest, this system helps bridge the gap between the smaller and larger events. This system will reward teams for their consistency on the competition circuit regardless of the event size. Example: the third place overall finisher at a 47 team contest would receive 200 points for their finish plus 11.75 bonus points (47/4), for a total of 211.75 points. A 16th place rib finish at the same event would earn 70 points plus 11.75 bonus points for a total of 81.75 points.

Kookers Kare BBQ teams can cook as many of the qualifying contest as they want. However, to calculate the overall and category winners in the Kookers Kare BBQ Series only the top 6 contest/category finishes will be used.
